


Utilities - ODS and M7 FS3 Databases – Update 02/21/07 cg

1. Copy Test Case

Copies an existing Test Case or Framework Procedure to one of a different name.

*(Warning:) needs error checking to prevent copying to the same PUI

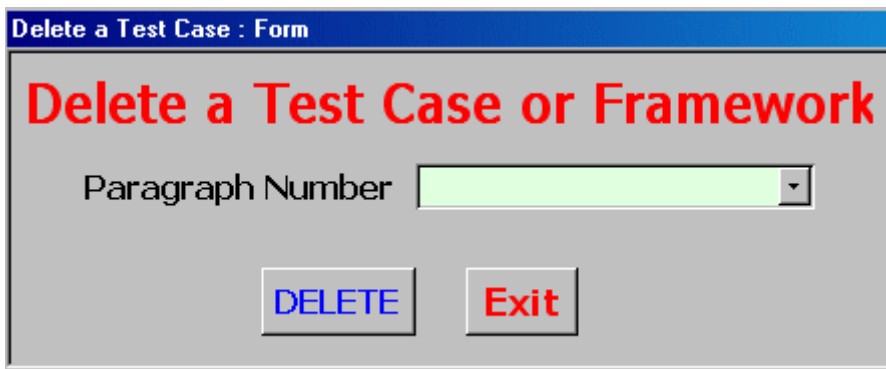
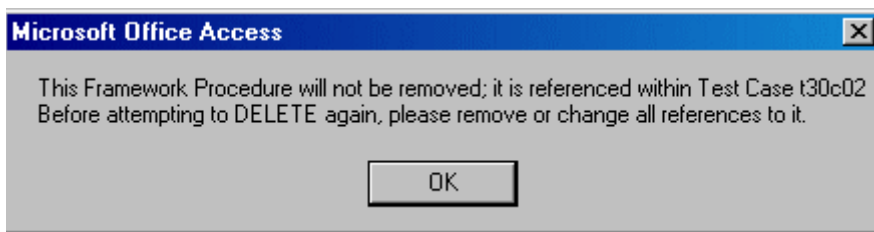

2. Delete Test Case

Deletes an existing Test Case or Framework Procedure. (Using Rename a Test Case is the more useful utility – deletion likely used ONLY to delete a test case added by mistake, or with mistakes.

(Note:) In answer to concerns expressed last night by OJ and Allen, code was added to prevent any Framework procedure linked to a Test Case from being deleted.


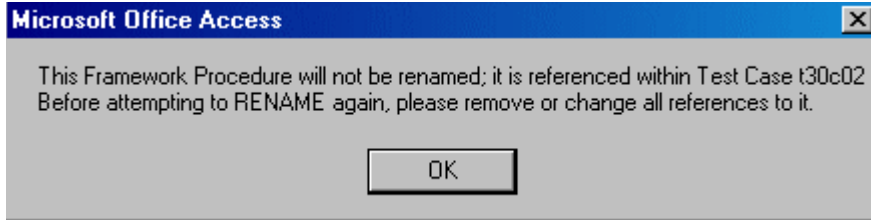
If such is the case, a message similar to the one below appears:



3. Rename a Test Case

Renames an existing Test Case or Framework Procedure. – either the PUI or the Test Case Name (Title)
